

# 100% of Religion Does Not Apply

---

The Bible has 66 books.

**Not all books of the Bible apply to everyone.**

**Eighty percent** of the Bible does not apply to the Body of Christ.

**NOTE** Any mention in this article of “the Body of Christ” refers to those individuals who have a relationship with God and possess the Spirit of God. The mention does not mean those followers of Roman or Covenant / Reformed Christianity who do not belong to God and have neither.

**The Body of Christ is not a religion. It is a relationship with God, and the abiding Spirit of God.**

## The Problem

The Christian religion is often referred to as the Body of Christ when it is not. The present day religion called Christianity is found nowhere in the Bible, does not conform to the teachings found in the Bible, rejects God’s message to mankind in this Age of Grace, and rejects the Apostle Paul and his letters written to the Gentiles.

**Fun Fact:** The Christian religion, Protestant or Catholic, is found nowhere in the Bible. It is a made-up religion of many systems loosely defined by Bible verses taken out of context, and / or made-up traditions, superstitions, beliefs, imaginations, extra-biblical writings, and practices that have no biblical support. Mormonism was created in such a manner.

The Christian religion simply took random verses from the Bible, out of context, to create the things they chose to believe in their made-up religions. Christianity believes that all the New Testament writings speak to them, mistakenly placing an emphasis on the four Jewish Gospels about the Jews and the life and ministry of the Gospel Jesus. They also pull verses from the Jewish Hebrew epistles (Hebrews through the Book of the Revelation) that were written by Jews, to Jews, for Jews, about Jews, the Jewish law, and Jewish things and Jewish times. These books speak of the Jewish law, the coming Tribulation, and the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth.

None of these books, writings, or Christianities version of Jesus, apply to the Gentiles as neither has application for the Gentiles. Neither do they apply to the Christian religion that chose to believe that they do. They were not written to the Gentiles, nor did the Jewish authors have the Gentiles in mind when they wrote their letters. None of this has any connection to Paul’s churches, Paul’s Gospel and Mystery, or the Body of Christ (Christ’s Church).

These Jews, and their writings to the Jews, are all obsolete: the Jews blinded, hardened, scattered, and their writings relegated to Jewish anthology along with the Old Testament, given to us today that

we might juxtapose law and grace, and see the mercy of God who adopted the Gentiles into the family of God.

With an emphasis on the four Jewish Gospels and the Jewish Hebrew letters, Christianity ignores God's message He sent to mankind through the Apostle Paul and his letters. Christianity uses select verses from Paul's writings, out of context, misunderstood and twisted, to support doctrines, beliefs, and propaganda that follow their personal theological leanings. These beliefs, systems, and imaginings do not exist in the Bible and are responsible for centuries of confusion in the Christian religion.

**Fun Fact:** The ascended Christ gave to Paul the ministry of reconciliation to go to the Gentiles and the word of reconciliation to preach to the Gentiles. This was a new message God had for the world, a message never heard before. This initiated the 2000-year Age of Grace that is all but complete.

As a result of their flawed understanding, the Christian religion holds to many different ideas and concepts, man-made traditions, imaginings, superstitions and fables, and words from the Bible taken out of context. Among these are a variety of different gospels, and often a version of Jesus that is not biblically accurate. This new Jesus exists as a false god for people to worship, a detraction from the one true God. Some groups teach a false spirit and a false god that is not the God of the Bible. Others follow the false goddess Mary to the same end.

**Fun Fact:** 1600 through 1900 years after Christ, the man-made religion called Protestant Christian simply went through the Bible picking out various verses to create the hodge-podge of things they chose to believe, totally disjointed and out of context. Their belief system has no continuity with the Bible and so, it is a false religion, plain and simple. This is why the Christian religion can believe

- The seven Churches of the Revelation belong to them
- They are the center of all religion
- They are the true Israel
- They are God's chosen
- God rejected the Jews and transferred all the blessings He gave to the Jews to The Christian religion
- The Jews retain all the curses,
- Deciding God did not really give the Jews the land of Canaan
- Jesus spoke directly to Christians 2000 years future telling them to "GO YE"
- Baptism is a thing, and
- Tithing is a thing,
- ...and I'm going to be an astronaut.

None of this is remotely true. It's fun to just say stuff. Just saying it doesn't make it so.

## The Inapplicable 80%

Fifty-three books of the Bible provide information only. These are very important books and the information they convey is invaluable, and not available from any other source. They are, however, descriptive of times past and do not provide guidance for Gentiles as to life and living. They do not provide doctrine for, or speak to the Body of Christ. Neither do they apply to the religion called Christian. Instead, they tell what happened in the past and foretell the future.

Let's look at the books that are informational to members of Christ's Church: the Body of Christ. Again, keep in mind, the Body of Christ is not the Christian religion of today, and the Christian religion is not the Body of Christ.

## The Four Jewish Gospels About the Jews

- The four Jewish Gospels are a continuation of the Old Testament.
- The four Jewish Gospels portray the arrival and ministry of the savior of the world, Jesus, as foretold by the Old Testament prophets.
- The four Jewish Gospels bring closure to all that came before in the Old Testament.
- The four Jewish Gospels are completely Jewish in focus and content and do not speak to the Gentiles at all.
- The four Jewish Gospels are descriptive of Jesus: His ministry and sacrifice for mankind.
- The four Jewish Gospel accounts describe details of events that happened in the past for our understanding, that we might see the big picture, the same as the Old Testament.
- The four Jewish Gospels finish the Old Testament - they present the final act in the story of mankind from Adam to Christ. It is the end of the law and the Jews. From here the world turns the page to a new story as God gives the world a new message through the Apostle Paul.
- Neither the Old Testament nor the four Jewish Gospels are prescriptive to the Gentiles in General, the Body of Christ specifically, and certainly do not apply to the corrupt Roman pagan Christian Church or its offshoot, Protestantism, still 1500 years future.
- The four Jewish Gospels, finished and made obsolete, the Jews that were hardened and blinded, then scattered across the globe,
- The four Jewish Gospels, finished and made obsolete, all the Jewish writings that do not apply to anyone in this Age of Grace, including the Jews.
- The four Jewish Gospel accounts describe a past time that occurred
  - before the existence of the Jewish Church of Acts 2.
  - before the existence of the Apostle Paul
  - before the existence of the Gentile believers and the Body of Christ, that is, Christ's Church
  - before Paul's Gospel
  - before Christ's revelation to Paul and the Mystery Hidden in God from the foundation of the world (Christ in you)
  - before the mystery of the calling out of the Body of Christ prior to the Tribulation, as told by Paul

- The four Jewish Gospel accounts of Jesus and His ministry do not support the Evangelical notion of missions and evangelism. Several religions take verses from the four Jewish Gospels and the Pauline epistles, out of context, to create their faulty mission focus.

**Consider** In the four Jewish Gospels, during His three-year ministry, Jesus went to the Jew only, deliberately omitting the Gentiles and calling them “dogs”, His words. Neither Jesus nor His disciples ministered to, or interacted with the Gentiles, avoiding them entirely, and referring to both the Gentiles and Samaritans as heathens, and sinners.

Post-ascension, Jesus commissioned the Apostle Paul to minister to the Gentiles with a new message that Christ never spoke to His disciples; information the world had never heard, information that God chose for the Gentiles to receive from the mouth of the Apostle Paul, information that had nothing to do with the Jewish Old Testament or the four Jewish Gospels.

That the Christian religion of today believes that Jesus, 2000 years ago, spoke specifically to them, a misguided, biblically ignorant group of Gentiles, without God or the Spirit of God, despising the Jews, preaching a false gospel, a false Spirit, and a phony Jesus, ignoring Christ’s messenger to the Gentiles, the Apostle Paul - and they thinking Jesus commanded them into the mission field to convert the world to their brand of made-up religion is beyond absurd.

## The Acts of the Apostles

- (a.k.a. “Acts”).
- Begins at the ascension of Christ and the beginning of the final 2000 years or mankind - the Age of Grace.
- Presents the history of the new Jewish Christian Church and the Apostle Peter: Acts chapters 2 - 8. There were no Gentile Body of Christ individuals associated with this church, and has nothing to do with the religion called Christian.
- Describes the history of the Apostle Paul’s ministry beginning with Saul’s Conversion to Paul, and the creation of the Pauline Body of Christ (Christ’s Church) Acts 9 and following.

**Fun Fact:** Nowhere in Acts, or the Bible in general, is there any mention of the Christian religion of today, Roman or Protestant.

**Fun Fact:** Acts 2 is a totally Jewish Church and was never connected to the Gentiles or the Body of Christ, and there is no connection or relation between the Acts 2 events and the Christian religion of today.

**Fun Fact:** Neither the Gentiles, nor the Body of Christ were ever called Christian anywhere in the Bible. The 4<sup>th</sup> century religion of today called Christianity is not the Body of Christ and is not mentioned anywhere in the Bible.

**Fun Fact:** The word Christian(s) appears in the Bible only three times and always and only referred to the Jews that believed Jesus was their Messiah. Neither the Gentiles nor the Body of Christ was ever called Christian.

**Fun Fact:** During the 30+ year ministry and writings of Peter, Paul, James, John, and Jude, no one ever used the term “Christian” to describe themselves, their people, or their church. “Christian” is a pejorative term given to the Jews by the culture of that day. It was not a term of honor or endearment.

## The Hebrew Epistles:

- The New Testament books of Hebrews through the Book of the Revelation
- Each written by a Jew, to Jews, for Jews, about Jews, the Jewish law, and Jewish things and Jewish times.
- None of these letters were written to the Gentiles or having the Gentiles in mind
- All language is Jewish
- Addresses Jews under the law
- The focus is on the works of the law
- Always carries the conditional: salvation “**IF**”
- Speaks to the future Kingdom of Heaven on earth -= Jew
- Speaks of the Tribulation
- Follows Peters Jewish Gospel not Paul’s Gospel to the Gentiles
- The writers only understood Jesus as the promised Messiah and nothing else. They did not understand Paul, his ministry, his Gospel, or the mystery of Christ in you.
- The Hebrew epistles are informational books for the Body of Christ in the same way the Old Testament and the four Jewish Gospels are informational only.
- All the Jewish writings were rendered obsolete in the Age of Grace.
- Contains no Pauline language
- Contains no doctrines for the Body of Christ

## The Applicable 20%

While all the books of the Bible are valuable for everyone, only 20% of the Bible applies to the Gentiles – you and me. These are the 13 Pauline Epistles, or letters, Paul wrote to the Churches. (These New Testament books are Romans through Philemon.)

## Paul's Epistles

If you took all the writings of the Apostle Paul and reduced his many words to the bare essence of Paul's message, the Pauline epistles are very simple and say the following:

**Paul's Gospel** Salvation available to all by God's grace through our faith and this because of Christ's death and resurrection.

**Paul's Mystery** Christ in You: The Spirit of God indwelling believers.

The Christian / Covenant / Reformed / Replacement / Amillennial religion complicates the simplicity of God's message given to us through Paul.

**Fun Fact:** There are many religions about God, but only one relationship with God. It is the relationship that matters, not religion. Religion is neither required nor desired.

The Body of Christ is not a religion: it is a relationship with God in the Spirit.

**Fun Fact:** Religion of any and every kind is the greatest satanic deception ever perpetrated on mankind in the history of the world. This includes Idolatry, Catholicism, Buddhism, Confucianism, Protestantism, and all the rest, .

The relationship with God is not religion, it is the abiding Spirit of God.

## 100% of Religion Does Not Apply to You

There are many religions about God. There is only one relationship with God. This relationship with God stands alone. It is complete in and of itself, above and beyond anything religion can offer.

A relationship with God renders the false religions and wayward teachings of the retail churches completely unnecessary. These churches should be avoided, especially in these last days of apostasy as they are blind and lost, and cannot offer spiritual growth or guidance, only confusion. These false teachings will distract you from the one true God and in many instances, prevent your salvation, and rob you of an eternity with God.

**Fun Fact:** If the Apostle Paul were with us today, he would warn the Body of Christ to have nothing to do with the false religions called Christianity and their false gospels, false Jesus, and false Spirit. And he would no doubt include an anathema or two.

The Christian religion ignores God's message to mankind through the Apostle Paul because the words in Paul's epistles contradict their propaganda, errant belief systems, and their self-appointed mission that modern-day religion has given itself. They completely miss Paul's simple truth.

**II Corinthians 11:3**

But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. 4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or [if] ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with [him].

Today, religions, with all subtilty, corrupt the minds of the people. Their sermons on self-help, a social gospel, and community involvement present a false Jesus, a false god, a false spirit, and a false gospel.

Forget religion. Find the relationship with God that He offers to everyone. Focus on the 20% of the Bible that applies to you. You'll be glad you did.
