

Go Ye, Go Ye Not

Matthew 28:19-20

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

When studying Scripture, the first three questions you should always ask a verse or passage:

- Who is speaking?
- Who is the speaker speaking to?
- Am I in the room?

In Matthew 28, Jesus is the speaker, speaking to His disciples, and

- You are not in the room
- The Apostle Paul is not in the room
- the Body of Christ is not in the room
- Gentiles are not in the room, and
- the Christian religion 2000 years future is not in the room

This Matthew reference has nothing to do with any of the above. Instead, this passage is a faithful account of a moment in Christ's ministry, intended for our information and understanding, nothing more. It is **not** given as a mission or a command to the world's inhabitants for all time as some religions choose to believe.

First: a few obvious points:

- Matthew 28:19-20 is a passage from the four Jewish Gospels.
- The four Jewish Gospels, in total, are Jewish books of Jewish times about the Jews exactly like the Old Testament, and have nothing to do with the Gentiles past, present or future. They provide information, not doctrine.
- The four Jewish Gospels are an extension / continuation of the Old Testament, bringing completion and closure to all that came before. It provides an end to all the writings, history, and prophecies that were for and about the Jews.
- The four Jewish Gospels describe the event where God Himself is interacting with the Jews. God has done this since the beginning of the world, this time, in the manifestation of the man Jesus. It is God making good on His promise of salvation that He made to the fathers of the Jewish people.

- ***“Jesus came to His own...”*** The Jews, He did not come to the Gentiles.
- The four Jewish Gospels have nothing to do with the Gentiles any more than the Old Testament writings: they provide valuable information, not guidance.
- The four Jewish Gospels do not mention, reference, apply to, or speak to the Body of Christ that did not exist at that time. Neither do they speak to the errant religions that developed centuries later based on misunderstandings and misinterpretations of God’s Word to man.
- The ascended Christ sent Paul to the Gentiles with God’s message, and that had nothing to do with the four Jewish Gospels in general, this Jewish passage in particular, or the Jewish law. Paul’s message did not find acceptance with the Jews who were hardened and blinded to the truth this entire 2000-year Age of Grace, and never did understand or accept Paul’s Gospel or God’s Mystery (Christ in you).
- The ministry Christ gave to Paul to preach to the Gentiles did not include the four Jewish Gospels, water baptism, tithing, Christ’s Jewish teachings, a command to “follow Jesus”, “make disciples for Jesus”, “have the ministry of Jesus” or any other such nonsense that is popular in religion today. Neither did it include a command to the Gentiles to “Go Ye” anywhere to do anything.
- The mention of “baptizing” is Jewish, and the first clue the Matthew verse was for a different time, a different people, and had/has nothing to do with the Body of Christ.
- The four Jewish Gospels, and Peter’s Jewish Gospel to the Jews, spoke of water baptism for the remission of sins. This has nothing to do with the Gentiles past or present. Water baptism was replaced by the miracle of the indwelling Spirit of God. This is the abiding Spirit of God: a spiritual baptism delivered to the Gentiles by Paul. It is the mystery hidden in God from the beginning of the world. Jesus never preached it and the disciples never heard it, and the Jews never found it.
- This verse to the disciples to GO YE went unanswered, as the Jews were hardened and scattered, and the disciples remained in Jerusalem and never did “Go Ye”.
- The disciples remained in Jerusalem waiting for Christ’s return until they died. They never went to the Gentile world or had anything to do with the Gentiles. They never wrote to the Gentiles, never preached or ministered to the Gentiles, never gave a second thought to the Gentiles they called dogs, heathens, and sinners. God did not send any of the disciples to the Gentiles. Instead, He sent Paul and only Paul.
- This passage is not a “Great Commission” and nowhere in the Bible is there any mention of a “Great Commission”. The term exists only in the imagination of the misguided religions that made it up and chose to devote their lives following it. It is a false interpretation and misunderstanding of something that never existed; an error from which people created a false religion.

A False Mission

What is the story with the “Go Ye” message the Christian religion preaches?

- Did Jesus command the Gentiles of His day to seek and save the lost?
- Did Jesus command the nonexistent Body of Christ to seek and save the lost?
- Did Jesus command the Christian religion of our day, 2000 years future, to seek and save the lost?
- Do these words apply to individuals in a personal, private, evangelical out reach to everyone they meet, “or else”?
- Are “saved Christians” duty-bound to carry out a God-given mandate of sharing their faith and making disciples?
- Are you, by reason of your salvation, conscripted into a full-time occupation of service missionizing the world?
- If evangelism is not the focus of your life, are you shirking your responsibility to God?
- If you fail to tell everyone you meet about God and the Bible, Jesus, and His sacrificial death, is God going to judge you, and you loose rewards in Heaven?

The answer to all the above is **NO!** Nothing here appears anywhere in the Bible. Religions that push such thoughts and ideas do so in ignorance of the Bible, creating doctrines, rituals, and practices that border on the superstitious. They are all man-made creations rooted in the imaginations of false religions that all lack biblical support.

Two People Groups

There are two people groups in the world: Jews and Gentiles, each with their own program and destiny. If you are a descendant of Abraham through Isaac, you are a Jew, otherwise, you are a Gentile. The Bible address these two groups in different places and with different content and different words. For the Gentiles, there is the Apostle Paul and his ministry to the nations (Gentiles), given to him by the ascended Christ. Paul's letters in the Bible contain the information God wants the Gentiles to hear and know during this 2000-year Age of Grace (Romans through Philemon).

There is other content - 80% of the Bible - that is not Pauline, but Jewish: written by Jews to Jews about Jews. The Jews, and the Jewish writings are obsolete in this new Age of Grace. The Jews scattered across the globe, their writings do not apply to the current program. These important writings like the Old Testament, are informational and provide the backdrop, the color, and feel of the ages, of mankind's progress through time in a 6000-year countdown from the time of Adam's sin to the end of humanity as we know it. Instead of a focus on the information that God gave the Gentiles, Christianity is all about the four-Jewish Gospels about the Jews, and the Jewish Hebrew epistles: information that has nothing to do with the Gentiles. The Christian religion is more Jewish-centric than people realize. This is a problem that manifests itself in the Christian religions separation from God and their blindness to all things Spirit and Bible.

Christianity

Christianity is not the Body of Christ.

Paul's message to the Gentiles was salvation by grace through faith, and the indwelling Spirit of God. This is the mystery hidden in the mind of God from the beginning of our world,. This is God's message given to us through the Apostle Paul that he would take it to the Gentiles. This miracle of "God in man" replaced all the first century miracles, signs and wonders, speaking in tongues, and healings. These latter miracles existed only to authenticate and validate Jesus, the Apostles, their ministries, and the early Jewish church. They are no longer necessary.

The Spirit indwelling also replaced temples, alters, tabernacles, cathedrals, sanctuaries, and church buildings. Now, each member of the Body of Christ is a temple of the living God with the abiding Spirit of God. There is no reason for the Body of Christ to go to such buildings to present themselves to God as the Jews did in times past, or as the pagans worshiped in their temples. God is in us. What this world knows of worship buildings is of pagan and Jewish origin, and does not apply to us today. Numerous false religions, in ignorance, have chosen to use this ancient model in their belief systems, including Christianity. They are unaware that the indwelling Spirit, in a relationship with God, is what differentiates and separates the Body of Christ from all of the empty fortune-cookie religions about God, or a god, or gods, that permeate our present world.

The Bible

Without the Spirit of God, no one can understand the things of God, and this includes the Bible. God created the Bible as a puzzle, and the Spirit is the Key. Those individuals who have God's Spirit - the Children of God, understand the Bible. When these people gather together, there is unity, and that through the same Spirit. This unity of one mind through Christ is the Pauline Church, the Body of Christ. This is not the Christian religion we see today that panders to a pagan audience in their worship of a fictitious Jesus character they created. The Body of Christ has nothing to do with the religion of the last 1900 years seen in corrupt Roman-ism and, more recently, the Protestant kaleidoscope of false religious beliefs and fragmented congregations.

Christianity, Protestant and Catholic, Apostolic, Anglican, Orthodoxy, and all the rest, are found nowhere in the Bible. These are all made-up religions in many systems loosely defined by random Bible verses taken out of context, and/or made-up traditions, superstitions, fables, stories, extra-biblical writings, and errant practices that lack any hint of biblical support. Mormonism and the other such religions were also fashioned in the same manner.

Fun Fact: The word Christian appears in the Bible only three times, and referred only to the Jews who believed Jesus was their Messiah. The term never applied to the Gentiles or the Body of Christ.

Fun Fact: In the 30 years-plus ministries of Peter, Paul, James, John, and Jude, no one ever used the term Christian to describe themselves, their followers, or their Church. It was a slang and a disparaging term.

Fun Fact: The Pauline Gentile Body of Christ was never called Christian. Paul never referred to his churches or his followers as Christian.

Fun Fact: The religion called Christian is not a biblical religion. It is a belief system that takes words from the Bible, out of context, to create the errant things they choose to believe.

Go Ye Not

Of the many religions under the umbrella of Protestantism, a large segment called Evangelical, believe that Jesus sent them into the mission field to bring people to God. This is not true. It is misdirected zeal, a figment of someone's imagination, and a product of their misinterpretation of the Bible. Men, without God's Spirit, with no understanding of the Bible, took Matthew 28:19, "Go Ye", out of context, and built from it an entirely dysfunctional religion of nearly 1 billion followers - from a misunderstanding.

Another group, the Bereans and the Grace Church movement, make a similar mistake in their "Greater Commission". They acknowledge the Evangelical error in Matthew 28, but choose a different passage from II Corinthians 5 for their fantasy mission to the world, and, of course, their passage is also taken out of context. They imagine that Paul gave their religion a ministry of reconciliation, and anointed them Ambassadors for Christ. Like the Matthew verse, this too, is untrue and has no biblical support.

Fun Fact: There is no such thing in all of the Bible as a "Great Commission" or a "Greater Commission". These are phrases coined by the wayward religions that invented the term, decided to make it their religion, and chose to spend their lives promoting and following a misunderstanding. It is not a biblical truth.

This new revelation of the Grace / Berean religion is only 100 years old and was never seen in times before. It is a misunderstanding of Paul, Paul's ministry, Paul's letters, the Bible, and a simple misreading of the II Corinthians text. This mistake is on par with the Pentecostal / Charismatic religions that take a single event from the Bible (Acts 2), out of context, and create from it an entire false religion devoted to speaking in tongues and other religious fakery and shenanigans.

In every case, the Christian religion, regardless of the name or brand, no matter how sincere in their motives, is nothing more than biblically ignorant people just making stuff up, unwitting participants in spreading biblical error in a satanic game of damn the dummies.

Note Studying the Bible, scripture always interprets scripture. For the Matt 28 and II Corinthians 5 verses to say what these wayward religions believe they say, given the gravity of what these people believe they mean, there would be numerous, clear, unimpeachable references throughout the New Testament repeatedly calling the Body of Christ to the ministry of reconciliation, anointing them ambassadors, and telling them to Go Ye and evangelize and missionize the world on threat of judgment from God. Instead - Zilch! There is not one mention of any such thing anywhere in the Bible,

and certainly not in Matthew or II Corinthians. These verses have a completely different meaning and context when compared to the faulty interpretations these groups preach. What these groups believe is a tradition of what someone thought the Bible meant, embellished over the centuries. It is certainly not biblical truth.

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Conclusion

In the four Jewish Gospels, during His three-year ministry, Jesus went to the Jew only, deliberately omitting the Gentiles and calling them "dogs", His words. Neither Jesus nor His disciples ministered to, or interacted with the Gentiles, avoiding them entirely, and referring to both the Gentiles and Samaritans as heathens, and sinners.

Post-ascension, Jesus commissioned the Apostle Paul to minister to the Gentiles with a new message that Christ never spoke to His disciples; information the world had never heard, information that God chose for the Gentiles to receive from the mouth of the Apostle Paul, information that had nothing to do with the Jewish Old Testament or the four Jewish Gospels.

That the Christian religion of today believes that Jesus, 2000 years ago, spoke specifically to them, a misguided, biblically ignorant group of Gentiles, without God or the Spirit of God, despising the Jews, preaching a false gospel, a false Spirit, and a phony Jesus, ignoring Christ's messenger to the Gentiles, the Apostle Paul - and they thinking Jesus commanded them into the mission field to convert the world to their brand of made-up religion is beyond absurd.

Fun Fact: If the Apostle Paul were with us today, he would warn the Body of Christ to have nothing to do with any of the false religions called Christian, and would have no doubt thrown in an anathema or two.

If you find yourself in one of these false religions, your eternity is at stake. Leave. You will never learn or grow in that environment. Instead, turn to a relationship with God, become a Biblicist and discover the truth. Your religion will do nothing but lead you astray, keep you from God, and derail your hopes of salvation.
