

## Protestantism

---

Protestantism is not the first century Pauline Body of Christ, aka Christ's Church of Believers. It is something else. It is not a good something else. It is not biblical.

Let's break it down and look at all the pieces.

**Fun Fact:** The Christian religion, Protestant or Catholic, Anglican or Orthodoxy, is found nowhere in the Bible. It is a made-up religion of many systems loosely defined by Bible verses taken out of context, and / or made-up traditions, superstitions, extra-biblical writings, and rituals that have no biblical support. Mormonism was also created in such a manner.

Protestantism, beginning in the 16<sup>th</sup> century, was the spawn of the corrupt Roman pagan Christian religion that began in the 4<sup>th</sup> century, and it having roots much earlier, back to the time of the Apostle Paul, and that's where our study begins.

## The Apostle Paul

The ascended Christ gave to Paul the ministry of reconciliation to go to the Gentiles, and the word of reconciliation to preach to the Gentiles. The Apostle Paul, through his epistles, proclaims the message God wants the Gentile nations to hear. The people that Paul reached (Gentiles) became the Body of Christ, defined as those individuals who have the Spirit of God, members of Christ's Church. This indwelling Spirit is the mystery hidden in God from the beginning of the world, and given to Paul by the ascended Christ that he should take it to the Gentiles. Paul's words were the standard for the Body of Christ in Paul's day, and remains so to this day. This is the message the present-day religion should be teaching, but they are not.

**Ephesians 3:8** Unto me (Paul), who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

**9** And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

**10** To the intent that now (Paul's Ministry) unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church (The Gentile Body of Christ) the manifold wisdom of God,

**Fun Fact:** The Body of Christ is not the religion called Christianity: Roman or Protestant.

Paul warned his churches to beware of individuals who preached a false gospel, a false spirit, and a false Jesus, and not God's message he had given to them, what Paul called "my Gospel". Indeed, there were many false ministers, false prophets, and Judaizers in his day that sought to bring Paul's church into bondage of the law, and other beliefs that would lead the Church astray. These individuals preached a different gospel, a lie, and not the true Gospel Paul preached that was given

to him by God. Also, there were other religions of knowledge, science-so-called, and vain philosophy to name just a few, and these same religions remain with us today.

**II Corinthians 1:4** For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

**Galatians 1:6** I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

**7** Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

**8** But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

**9** As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

**Fun Fact:** If the Apostle Paul were with us today, he would warn the Body of Christ to have nothing to do with the many false religions called Christian, all preaching a false gospel, false spirit, and a false Jesus. Paul would also add an anathema or two.

Paul knew that when he was gone, the churches he had established would come under attack.

**Act 20:28** Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

**29** For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock.

**30** Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

**31** Therefore watch, and remember, that by the space of three years I ceased not to warn every one night and day with tears.

And that's exactly what happened. Once Paul was off the scene, his church morphed into a religion affected and infected by many influences of the day. This new religion eventually took up the name "Christian", void of God's message, lacking God and God's Spirit.

**Fun Fact:** The Pauline Gentile Body of Christ was never called Christian.

**Fun Fact:** The term Christian(s) is used only three times in the Bible, and each mention refers to the Jews who believed Jesus was the Messiah. No one ever called the Gentiles or the Body of Christ "Christians".

**Fun Fact:** In the 30 year-plus ministries of Peter, Paul, James, John, and Jude, no one ever used the term Christian to describe themselves, their followers, or their Church.

**Fun Fact:** The title “Christian” was a slang; a pejorative, disparaging term given by the Roman culture to the Jews who believed in Jesus as their Messiah. This is the Acts 2 Jewish Christian Church and that had nothing to do with the Gentiles then, the Body of Christ, and certainly had nothing to do with the corrupt Roman Christian religion, or the 16<sup>th</sup> century Protestant religion calling itself Christian.

## The Christian Church

Two and a half centuries after Paul (75 years before the United States gained independence), in a political move to unite the many religious factions of the Roman Empire, Constantine sanctioned a new, all encompassing religion he called “Christian” in honor of his mothers faith. This was not the Pauline Body of Christ. Instead, this new “official” government religion had pagans and elements of philosophy, science-so-called, Gnosticism, Humanism, idolatry, superstitions, and many more. Within these ranks was a despise of the Jewish people who they called Christ killers.

**Fun Fact:** Think about it: how many people do you know from 1701? if you were a Roman Christian in 313 AD, and there were no Bibles at all, what are the odds that you would know anything about the Apostle Paul who preached 270 years earlier?

“Christianity” focused on the four Jewish Gospels that had nothing to do with the Gentiles, and the Gospel Jesus, who called the Gentiles dogs. That is all the first Roman pagan Christians knew and not much of that. Through time, 1700 years to be exact, the focus never changed and Paul was never a thought. Paul’s epistles never gained the prominence they deserved as the message from God to mankind.

Christianity unilaterally decided that God had abandoned the Jews, and transferred to the Christian Church all the blessings and promises God had given the Jews. The Christian Church also usurped the title of Israel, and denied that God ever gave the promised land to the Jews, or that the Jews had any right to this land God gave to Abraham and his descendants for all time. This emphatic belief of Christianity lives on today in Replacement Theology and anti-Zionism.

For these reasons, and many more, the Christian religion did not have God’s blessings from its inception, and its followers never received the indwelling Spirit of God. This condition remains to this day, and this goes a long way in explaining the biblical disparity inherent in this religion.

## Covenant Theology

A century after Constantine commissioned the Christian religion of Rome, a Bishop of the Roman Church, Augustine, created his own brand of theology that became “Covenant” religion. His religious dogma had no connection to Paul or the Spirit of God, but focused on mans efforts in seeking a higher spiritual plain by mechanically following words in the Bible. This was no better then any other fortune-cookie religions before or after his time. It was a false, humanistic religion of man’s self effort

to better himself and thereby attempt to please God. This is not the Body of Christ, and not God's message to mankind through Paul.

**Fun Fact:** Notice that the Mormon and Catholic Churches are alive and well in this day-and-age despite their total ignorance of all things God and Bible. Hinduism and Islam also thrive as does the Anglican Church, Orthodoxy, Buddhism, and Confucianism. So too, the cults and the occults, the atheists, and agnostics, and religions of the far east. There are numerous other religions that fit this mold including the many shades of Protestantism. All told, these belief systems represent billions of lost souls, the vast bulk of humanity.

God allows these false religions and non religions to continue as the wheat and the tares. Very soon, the removal of the Body of Christ from the earth (the rapture) will separate God's children from the lost and the religious, who follow a form of godliness, but deny the power thereof.

Here are just a few of the many errant points contained in Covenant Theology practiced to this day:

- Addresses the Bible allegorically, insisting no one can understand the Word of God apart from spiritualizing the text
- Reformed Theology: God is finished with the Jews and gave all the Jewish blessings to the Christian Church
- Antisemitic
- Christ will not take us to heaven until the church brings peace to the world
- Christ already returned to earth
- Christ is presently reigning over the earth from heaven
- Amillennialism: There is not a 1,000-year reign of Christ
- No Tribulation
- No Rapture
- Religious foundation is the Four Jewish Gospels taken out of context
- The Great Commission taken out of context
- Evangelicalism is out of context
- Ignores The Apostle Paul
- Their Jesus is not necessarily the Jesus of the Bible
- And so on.

## Roman Religion

Over the centuries, without the Spirit of God, the Roman religion hid the Bible from the people, outlawed the Bible, burned Bibles, plundered cultures, and sanctioned rape, torture, and murder in the name of their false god. These christian church armies would kill anyone that disagreed with their bastardized religion during centuries of "UN-holy" crusades, and mired itself in corruption of all kinds. Instead of the Word of God, they substituted traditions that were whatever they wanted to make up. In the dark ages, wielding an iron fist, with an illiterate populous and no Bible, they could get away with anything. Today, not so much. Still, Over 1.5 billion people belong to and follow this false religion.

## Protestantism, Then

In the 15<sup>th</sup> century, the printing press produced Bibles faster then the perverse church could find and destroy them. It would take another century before literacy took hold. People finally saw the corrupt government church for what it was and began leaving in droves. But leaving their Roman religion didn't mean they were smart, and it didn't make them smarter. All these orphans ever had was a life-time of false Augustinian religion and stained-glass windows: no Bible, and no Spirit of God. They had "Sola This" and "Sola That", taking words mechanically from the Bible, but lacked the Spiritual guidance to connect the dots and see the big picture. They were as blind as before, just without the Roman leash.

**Fun Fact:** The Christianity of Rome in the 4<sup>th</sup> century, and all the variations of Christianity since, are nowhere found in the Bible. They are inventions of men who did not have the Spirit of God and did not understand the Bible. These are all man-made religions, much like Mormonism, that exist to this day, virtually unchanged.

The early Protestant religion grew, but without God's guidance through the Spirit. The many beliefs men created were little more than a haphazard, hodge-podge collection of any idea someone might come up with, and that through reading the little bits and pieces of the Bible they could find.

As an example, the Anabaptists had parts of a Gospel that mentioned John's baptism by immersion. They immediately took issue with Roman-ism that insisted on infant baptism for the salvation of the child's soul. The Anabaptists went to the wall with their idea of adult baptism until the ruling religion began killing them off. And it was all for nothing. The Anabaptists did not realize the Jewish Gospels had nothing to do with the Gentiles, or that Paul's God-given message to mankind had nothing to do with water baptism. This was a true tragedy, completely unnecessary, the result of biblical ignorance. The same is true of the Amish and all the other religions that began in this era. Sadly, all these religions remain today in some form or fashion, mostly unchanged.

**Fun Fact:** Protestantism, in its ignorance, focused on the four Jewish Gospels, the Jewish Hebrew epistles, and the Gospel Jesus. These had nothing to do with the Gentiles. All of these writings were rendered obsolete in the Age of Grace

relegated to a place with the Old Testament Scriptures: providing valuable information found nowhere else. The Apostle Paul had God's message to the Gentiles, but the Christian religion ignored Paul then as they do today because God's message through Paul is not what they want to hear, and does not align with what they choose to believe.

**Fun Fact:** The Christian religion, believing they are Israel, having all of God's blessings that formerly belonged to the Jews, mistakenly thinks all the Bible is meant for them, and that every page contains doctrine for Christian life and living. As such, they mix the entire Bible into a confusing, contradictory theological soup of law and grace that no one can understand, makes no sense, and misleads their followers.

**Fun Fact:** All the Bible is profitable for everyone, just not doctrine for everyone. 80% of the Bible does not apply to the Gentiles. Only the Pauline epistles. Paul's epistles, contain the message God gave to the Gentiles through the Apostle Paul, and this does not include water baptism, tithing, or the 10 Commandments, among many other things. Shoehorning the four Jewish Gospels and the Jewish Hebrew epistles into the Gentile world of "saved by grace" doesn't make any sense and doesn't work.

## Protestantism Today

Beginning in 1900, Christianity took a wicked left turn in a progressive, liberal direction, coinciding with the 120<sup>th</sup> Jubilee and the final 120-year countdown of mankind. While religion to that point did not understand the Bible, still, it had a fundamental core and an idea of Christ and salvation. In this new liberal religion where anything goes, Jesus, and even God Himself, are redefined into whatever form any religion chooses. Clear doctrines of the Bible are redefined or dropped, and the churches now major in self-help sermons and a social gospel, and have "progressed" so far that the now decades old Emergent Church is nothing more than a form of far-east mysticism and new age religion with Bible subtleties. People no longer find the church relevant and long ago turned away to the destruction of their lives, our society, and culture, if you ever wondered how we got here.

**Fun fact:** God, throughout the Bible, makes it abundantly clear that His plan for mankind, the Millennial Week, will span 6000 years, culminating in the 1000-year reign of Christ. The 6 day week and a "sabbath rest" is a pattern of God's master plan that He codified in the fourth commandment as a remembrance, so that humanity is without excuse. ....remember the sabbath day....

God's Millennial Week also encompasses the Grand Jubilee: 120 Jubilees from Adam to today:  $6000 \div 50 = 120$  Jubilees. The Jewish Jubilee system is a trigger to release slaves, forgive debts, return property, no agricultural work, and more. In this final Jubilee of our time, much the same happens, but on a grand scale, where the earth is returned to God, sins are forgiven, Satan is bound, and the people are set free from the sin and unrighteousness of this present age.

This is a parallel with the final 120 years God gave Noah to build the ark before the world was destroyed by a global flood due to man's wickedness. This same pattern also mirrors our last 120 years God has given to us in this technological build-up before the rapture of Christ's Church and the Tribulation.

Consider: In these last 120 years, mankind went from the 5880 years of horse and buggy to incredible technological advances, all in preparation for the Tribulation and the end of the world.

## The List of Errors
