

The Apostle Paul

Christian religion mistakenly draws its doctrines from the four Jewish Gospels, the life of the Gospel Jesus, and the Jewish Hebrew epistles (Hebrews through the Book of the Revelation). Yet, none of these writings say anything to the Gentiles. This leads to false religions and numerous errant doctrines that do not align with the Bible or apply to the Body of Christ, or the Gentiles in general. This error has been going on for 500 years.

Fun Fact: The Christian religion is nowhere found in the Bible. This includes the Pentecostal religion and its derivatives, Catholicism, Evangelicalism, Lutheranism, and other religions under the Protestant umbrella. These are all made-up religions, created with words from the Bible, taken out of context, and / or traditions, superstitions, practices, rituals, stories, fables, and extra-biblical writings, that have no biblical support. Mormonism is the same type of religion created by man in the same fashion.

Christ called the Apostle Paul to minister to the Gentiles, giving him the ministry of reconciliation to reach the Gentiles, and the word of reconciliation to preach to the Gentiles. 4. Paul's Mystery: The indwelling Spirit of God given to all who believe

Taking the highlights of Paul's life:

- Saul, the persecutor of the Jewish Christian Church
- Paul, redeemed by Christ unto a ministry to the Gentiles

Many religions today errantly emphasize the four Jewish Gospels about the Jews, the Jewish Hebrew epistles written to the Jews, and a caricature of a phony Jesus found nowhere in the Bible. All of these Jewish writings are obsolete and have been for 2000 years. They do not have, and never had anything to do with the Gentile world which. The Christian religion ignores God's message to mankind, the message God sent to us through the Apostle Paul.
