

## The Bride of Christ

Protestant religion believes that those who attend their churches are “the Bride of Christ”. This is not true. There is no Biblical support for such a belief.

**Fun Fact:** The religion called Christian is nowhere found in the Bible. It is a man-made religion people created over the years, using words from the Bible, out of context, and/or made-up ideas, imaginations, superstitions, traditions, extra-biblical writings, and errant practices they choose to follow that have no Biblical support. Throughout the Old and New Testaments, God compares His relationship to Israel as a marriage. The Bride of Christ is the New Jerusalem; a city, not a people.

### **Revelation 21**

**:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.**

**:9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb’s wife.**

**10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,**

**23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb [is] the light thereof.**
