

This Gospel, That Gospel

Gospel means “Good News”. There are many proclamations of good news throughout Scripture, both Old and New Testaments. When speaking of the New Testament, there are three variations of “Good News” to choose from, plus a number of false gospels.

1. The Jewish Gospel Jesus gave to his disciples as recorded in the four Jewish Gospels about the Jews
2. The post resurrection Jewish Christian Gospel Peter’s Gospel to the Jews only, Acts chapters 2-8
3. The Apostle Paul to the Gentiles and what he calls “My Gospel”
4. The various false “Gospels” found in modern-day religion

The Jewish Gospel of Jesus in the four Jewish Gospels

- *Jesus to His Disciples*
- *The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand*
- *This Gospel of the four Jewish Gospels is Jewish history, a time past and does not apply today.*
- *This Gospel had nothing to do with the Gentiles, the Gentile Body of Christ, or a future Gentile religion called Christian.*
- *Many Christian religions today errantly call this Gospel their “Gospel”.*

The Post Ascension Jewish Christian Gospel

- *Peter’s Jewish Gospel to the Jews:*
- *Believe in Jesus as the Messiah, repentance, and water baptism for the remission of sins*
- *This Gospel had nothing to do with the Gentiles, the Gentile Body of Christ, or a future Gentile religion called Christian.*
- *Many Christian religions today errantly call this Gospel their “Gospel”.*

The Pauline Gospel

- *Paul’s Gospel to the Gentiles: What the Apostle Paul repeatedly calls “My Gospel”*
- *Given to Paul by Christ that he would take it to the nations*
- *God’s message to the world through the Apostle Paul*
- *Applicable to all of mankind*
- *Salvation by God’s Grace through our faith*
- *Christ in You - the indwelling Spirit of God*

- *Jews did not accept of receive Paul's Gospel due to their hardened hearts and spiritual blindness*
- *Paul's Gospel was not available during the four Jewish Gospels or the Acts Jewish Christian Church (Acts chapter 2 through chapter 8.)*
- *Many Christian religions do not recognize, understand, or acknowledge God's message to mankind through Paul's Gospel, or the messenger: the Apostle Paul.*

The Modern-Day Gospel

- *Various Religions:*
- *Multiple False Gospels*

The Gospel of Jesus in the Four Jewish Gospels

The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand

The Gospel message Jesus taught His disciples was unique to the Jews and did not include the Gentiles at all: not then, and certainly Jesus did not include the false Roman pagan Christian Church 300 years future, or its spin-off, Protestantism, beginning 1500 years future. In fact, the religion of today called Christianity that Constantine organized in the 4th century does not exist anywhere in the Bible. It is a made-up religion created from many influences, most notably, pagan.

During the time of Jesus and the four Jewish Gospels:

- There was no Paul
- The Body of Christ - Christ's Church - did not exist:
- The Spirit indwelling did not exist, this being the mystery hid in God from the beginning of the world, given to the Apostle Paul by the ascended Christ that he should preach it to the Gentiles.

The Gospel Jesus gave to His Jewish disciples was simply that the Kingdom of heaven is at hand, instructing them to take this message to the Jews only, not to the Gentiles or the Samaritans, "saying,

Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 10:5-7.

Many variations of Protestantism preach this "Gospel of the Kingdom" in error because it is the only Gospel found in the four Jewish Gospels and the religion has a fixation on all the Jewish writings. Protestantism wrongly holds to the four Jewish Gospels as though these writings had something to do with the Gentiles. They do not, any more than the Old Testament Jewish animal sacrificial system applies to Gentiles. The four Jewish Gospels are Jewish history, a continuation and fulfillment of the Old Testament, and have no direct application for the Gentiles of this day.

Below are a few references to the Gospel message found in the four Jewish Gospels.

Matthew_3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew_4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew_4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom,

Matthew_9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew_10:7 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew_24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Mark_1:14 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

Mark_1:15 And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Mark_16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

Luke 9:2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

Luke 9:6 And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing every where.

Peter's Post-Christ, Jewish Christian Gospel (Acts 2)

Believe in Jesus as the Messiah, repent, and be baptized for the remission of sins.

Fun Fact: The Jews denied that Jesus was their Messiah and crucified Him. They needed to believe that Jesus was their Messiah as foretold by the prophets and accept Him. This was the Apostle Paul's emphasis to the Jews in his epistle to the Romans, a book often misquoted in Protestant Evangelicalism to support their propaganda and non-biblical emphasis on Gentile missions and evangelism.

The only thing the Jews ever understood was Jesus as the Messiah. They never understood God's message or Paul.

After Christ's resurrection, there were Jews who believed that Jesus was their promised Messiah as foretold in their Scriptures (our Old Testament). These Jewish believers called upon their non-believing Jewish brethren to believe in Jesus as their Messiah.

This was the Jewish Christian Church of Acts 2: Jews believing Jesus as their Messiah, living under the Jewish law, fully Jews with all the feasts and dietary restrictions, works, circumcision, expecting the Tribulation, anticipating the return of Jesus to the earth and His millennial earthly reign.

1. There were no Gentile Body of Christ believers associated with Peter and this Acts 2 church.
2. There were no Body of Christ believers on the planet at the time of Acts 2
3. The Apostle Paul did not exist at the time of Acts 2.
4. Peter never ministered to, spoke to, or wrote to the Gentiles. Only to the Jews.
5. The future religion called Christian had no part in, and nothing to do with the Acts 2 Church and vice-a-versa.
6. The present-day religion called Christian is in no way connected to the Acts 2 Jewish Christian religion, its church, Peter, Paul, the Body of Christ, the Spirit of God, Christ's Church, The New Testament, or any other part of the Bible.

The Jewish "Christians" were Jews under the law, were required to perform the law, and if they persevered under the law in good works, they might ultimately find salvation. This "conditional" salvation was not in Heaven but in the Heaven on earth under the reign of Christ in the Millennial Kingdom.

Fun Fact: In the Matthew and Luke Jewish Gospels, when Jesus taught the disciples to pray "Our Father, who art in Heaven.... On earth as it is in Heaven....." This was to the Jews only with no connection to the Gentiles. The Jews have an earthly future, not a heavenly future. The Body of Christ has a future in Heaven. Nowhere in the Bible is it ever said that Jews have a place in Heaven, only on earth.

Fun Fact: There are three groups of people: Jews, Gentiles, and the Body of Christ. The religious Gentile people that do not belong to the Body of Christ the Bible calls "nations". These are the ones that say to Jesus "Didn't we do this and that in your name?" To whom Jesus replies, "I never knew you". This is the fate of the Christian religion.

The law, obedience, conditional salvation, the Tribulation, and their future life on earth with Jesus as King is the focus of the four Jewish Gospels and all the **New Testament Hebrew epistles:** (Hebrews through the Book of the Revelation). In these Jewish epistles, nothing was written to the Gentiles. There is only Jewish language, no doctrines for the Gentiles, no doctrines for the Body of Christ, no Pauline language at all. These Jewish books are Jewish history and provide perspective for the Body of Christ. All these writings are obsolete, made so by the ascension of Christ, God turning to the Gentiles through Paul, and God hardening, blinding, and scattering the Jews in the entire 2000-year period called the Age of Grace.

Fun Fact: Peter proclaimed the Jewish Gospel, never the Pauline Gospel, or anything Pauline, and never ministered to or taught the Gentiles, or wrote to the Gentiles. There is no Gentile connection to Peter. Peter was never the Pope of a Gentile Roman Christian Church scheme. This is a story someone made up. There is no historical or biblical truth to support it.

In contrast, Paul's Gospel to the Gentiles offered believers immediate salvation apart from the law, and a Heavenly position with Christ. Paul also proclaimed the mystery hid in God from the beginning of the world: Christ in you - the indwelling Spirit of God who would quicken their minds, guard their hearts and affections, change them into a new spiritual creation. Not so with Peter and the Jewish Christians under the law. Peter never understood Paul or spoke of Paul's Gospel, or the mystery given to Paul. Neither did Peter preach to the Gentile Body of Christ. Paul never preached Peter's Gospel to the Gentiles, or the Gospel Jesus proclaimed in the four Jewish Gospels as neither applied to anyone.

Fun Fact: Peter's good news (the Jewish Gospel) that he and the disciples were spreading to other Jews only, was the belief in their risen Messiah, repentance, and baptism for the remission of sins. This was the formula for salvation for those Jews who denied Jesus as their Messiah. This message never had anything to do with the Gentiles. Yet, some Protestant sects preach this gospel message in ignorance.

Fun Fact: The Roman culture labeled these Messianic Jews who believed Jesus as their Messiah: "Christians". It was a pejorative term, not one of endearment.

Fun Fact: The word Christian(s) appears in the Bible only three times, refers to Jews only, and never to Gentiles of any kind.

Fun Fact: In the 30+ years of their ministry, neither Peter, Paul, James, John, or Jude ever used the term "Christian" to describe themselves, their followers, or their church.

Fun Fact: Gentile believers, aka the Body of Christ, were never called Christians and Paul never used the term.

Fun Fact: At the time of Acts 2, there were no Gentile believers as Paul did not yet exist.

Fun Fact: Peter was a Jew to the Jews, never went to the Gentiles, and never understood God's message through Paul.

The Post-Christ Jewish Church and its Gospel proclaimed the resurrection of Jesus, proving His lineage from David, His Messiahship, and the coming earthly Kingdom of Heaven on earth.

Here are a few references to Peter's Jewish "Christian" Gospel.

Acts_2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

Acts_2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of **Jesus** Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 3:14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

Acts 3:15 And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

Acts 3:19 Repent ye (**Jews**) therefore, and be converted, that your (**Jews**) sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Acts 3:20 And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you (**Jews**):

Acts 3:26 Unto you first (**Jews**) God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you (**Jews**), in turning away every one of you (**Jews**) from his iniquities.

Fun Fact: The Jewish Gospel - Peter's Gospel - was sent only to the Jews, never to the Gentiles, and was quite different from both the Gospel message contained in the four Jewish Gospels and the Pauline Gospel message.

Acts 11:19 Now they (**Jews**) which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

The Pauline Gospel

Paul repeatedly calls his Gospel "my Gospel" as it is unique to him and different from the others. In contrast to the previous Gospels, 1) The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand and 2) believe Jesus as the messiah, repent and be baptized, Paul's Gospel, given to him by the ascended Christ to take to the Gentiles, was salvation by grace through faith. This Gospel was for the Gentiles, a heavenly people, where as the Jews are people of the earth: two distinctly different people with two distinctly different programs and two distinctly different destinies.

Paul wrote to his churches saying that if anyone brings to you a different gospel, a different Jesus, a different spirit other than that which Paul preached, they were to have nothing to do with the person or the message.

Galatians 1:6 ¶ I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than

that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any [man] preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

II Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

This includes the Gospel Jesus spoke to the Jews concerning the Kingdom of Heaven. His was not the Gospel for the Gentiles and was never given to the Gentiles. Instead, that same Jesus gave Paul a different Gospel to take to the Gentiles. The religions today still promote Jesus' Jewish Gospel to their followers in error. Paul told his church then, and today, not to follow a Gospel other than the one he preached, that the ascended Christ gave to him specifically to take to the Gentiles. This also applies to Peter's Jewish Gospel to the Jews. Not for us. Again, many religions today preach "repentance and water baptism for the remission of sins" or "the Kingdom is at hand". These do not apply to the Body of Christ, and does not apply to the religion that took up the name Christian and decided to adopt those gospel messages as their own.

Fun Fact: The Christian Church, spanning 1700 years, is found nowhere in the Bible - it is a man-made religion that began in the post-Apostolic period, organized by the Roman Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, and characterized by the Theology of Augustine in the 5th century. This Augustinian Theology is what we see in the various Christian religions of today. The Reformation eliminated many errant Roman "traditions", but retained the theological errors of Augustinianism.

Fun Fact: Neither the Roman nor the Protestant religious derivatives ever had the Spirit of God or God's blessings due to their anti-Zionist beliefs.

Fun Fact: The Jews experienced the operation of the Spirit: or the filling of the Spirit. This happened also in the Old Testament. These spiritual fillings were the Spirit of God temporarily working through men to validate their mission and ministry, such as the operation of tongues seen in Acts 2. This is not the permanent indwelling Spirit to a life change, and a new spiritual creation in the new man brought to the Gentiles by the Apostle Paul.

Fun Fact: The miracles, signs, and wonders active during the time of Jesus in the four Jewish Gospels, and during the time of the Apostles covered in the book of Acts, were replaced with the greater miracle of the mystery hidden in God from the beginning of the world: the indwelling Spirit of God residing in man.

Fun Fact: While Peter held to the Gospel model of water baptism for the remission of sins, there is no water baptism in Paul's Gospel or teachings, it having been replaced with the spiritual baptism of the indwelling Spirit. This is the same

with Christ's once-for-all sacrifice that replaced the Jewish animal sacrificial system.

Fun Fact: Paul's Gospel he took to the Gentiles is not found in the four Jewish Gospels, and that Gospel is nowhere found in Paul's epistles to the Gentiles. Neither did Paul speak or teach the events found in the four Jewish Gospels, and he did not repeat the teachings of Jesus as does James in his epistle to the Jews. James never wrote to the Gentiles, let alone the 20th century Christians.

Here are just a few verses from the Pauline epistles expounding Paul's Good News:

1 Corinthians_1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the **gospel**: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.

1 Corinthians_15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the **gospel** which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

Romans 2:16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

Romans 16:25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

Colossians_1:27 To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Ephesians 1:7 [speaking of Christ] In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Ephesians 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

Ephesians 2:16 And that he might reconcile both (Jew and Gentile) unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

Ephesians 2:19 Now therefore ye (Gentiles) are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

Ephesians 3:3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

Ephesians 3:6 That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:

Summary

1. Simply, both Paul and Peter preached a Gospel of Christ's resurrection.
2. Peter saw the resurrection as Christ's messiahship, and the assurance of God's coming Kingdom on earth.
3. Paul, on the other hand, preached Christ's resurrection as the gateway to salvation, a transformative change into a new spiritual creation in the Body of Christ, and the removal of the Body of Christ from the earth prior to the tribulation.
4. Both Gospels were very different, one from the other, each meant for its respective audience of two very different people groups.

The False Gospels

Satan is very subtle in his trickery. He is called a liar from the beginning and the father of all lies. Over the last 6000 years, he has never ceased his assault on humanity, seeking the destruction, the debasement, and the ruination of every living soul, and the annihilation of every good thing through lies, half-truths, disguise, deception, misinterpretation, misrepresentation, even the direct attack upon the children of God through the men of perverse, wayward religions. Nothing is off the table in his no-holds-barred war against God, God's world, and God's children.

Fun Fact: Religion of every type is the single greatest satanic deception ever perpetrated upon the world, from idolatry, Confucianism, Islam, Christianity, and the rest.

The Body of Christ is not a religion, it is a relationship with God.

Religions abound that proclaim themselves "Christian", "Biblical", "Gospel believers", "Followers of Christ", "Spirit filled", "Full Gospel", 4 Square, and so on. Yet, the adherents of these belief systems have no part in the Body of Christ. Catholics, Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, Evangelicals, Presbyterians, Charismatics, Pentecostals, and many more, all claiming the Bible as the inerrant Word of God and their singular, authoritative guide for life and living.

- What can be confusing is that these religious groups can articulate precisely the Gospel message of salvation by grace through faith in Jesus, and other Bible verses. However, all this means is that they know how to read. Anyone can do it. The problem is what they believe, preach, and teach betrays them as having nothing to do with the truth of the Bible. This is a classic satanic ploy of deception - what religion says sounds right, but the subtle shift in the meaning of the words is just enough to hide the truth in a lie.

- Religions rattle off Bible verses, but out of context, redefining those words to suit their personal beliefs. Simply chanting “salvation through Jesus” and quoting a few out-of-context Bible verses does not legitimize a false religion of false doctrines, a false gospel, a false Jesus, a false Spirit, and false gods.

Using the exact words from the Bible, but redefining those words is a satanic trick in line with Christ’s temptation in the wilderness and the temptation of Eve. Satan twists the truth ever so subtly to create the delicious lie that mislead many.

What the religions of our day preach may sound believable, but, like Satan’s trickery, it is all halve-truths and lies. Let’s look at a few examples.

Catholics

False Gospels: many

- *Salvation Requires Works*
- *Infant Baptism*
- *Infused Grace Through Communion*
- *Forgiveness of Sins by the Priesthood*
- *Transubstantiation*
- *Numerous Made-Up Traditions Pawned Off as Truth*
- *many more.....*

The Catholic Church claims allegiance to the Bible, but holds to traditions, superstitions, imaginings, mysticism, errant beliefs and practices, and extra-biblical writings that are decidedly not biblical and many are non-biblical. They place these false ideas and teachings along side or above the Bible. Their press says they believe in the Gospel of Christ. So do the Mormons.

This author has found nothing in the Catholic religion that has any biblical truth, just a lot of Bible words taken out of context.

Here are just a few of the non-biblical beliefs held by the Catholic Church. None of these beliefs are true or biblical.

1. Church teachings and traditions trump the Bible
2. Changed the 10 commandments, eliminating the command “do not pray to graven images”.
3. Prayers to statues and graven images
4. The Pope is the Vicar of / speaks for Christ
5. The infallibility of the Pope
6. The ability of the Pope to add to / change the Bible

7. Transubstantiation: calling Christ down daily to sacrifice Him anew, and the elements being the actual body and blood of Jesus. And this happens thousands of times a day around the world. This is pure religious fakery.
8. Transubstantiation: the requirement of the daily infusion of God's grace through communion that does nothing for a person beyond a possible placebo affect.
9. Tithing required
10. Celibacy
11. Mariology - the pagan worship of a female goddess, Mary, Jesus' mother, with many assorted imaginings including perpetual virginity, her heavenly assumption, co-regent with Christ, Queen of Heaven, and more: a false goddess to distract the people from the real, one true God.
12. Corporate worship - this is a pagan addition to Christianity from the 4th century that lives on today in Protestantism.
13. Purgatory
14. Prayers for the dead
15. Confessionals and penance for the forgiveness of sins - basically indulgences.
16. Last Rights
17. Infant baptism as saving the soul of a child
18. "the need of the new birth in baptism, to be freed from the power of darkness and brought into the realm of the freedom of the children of God..." It doesn't. Tradition and Superstition, nothing more, not biblical.
19. The need of a priest to intercede to God on your behalf
20. Praying to statues
21. Laymen cannot understand the Bible
22. Last rights
23. ...and more superstitions and traditions that have no biblical support - Just made-up stuff in a made-up religion.
...and so many more, all religious quackery.

The Roman Church, from the beginning, and through the centuries, has been badly deceived, misleading their clergy, monks (male and female), and followers, in a religion that lands far afield of the Bible.

There is no salvation in the Roman Church.

The Mormons

False Gospels: many

- *Followers can be a god in Heaven (Satan's lie to Eve)*

The Mormon Church says they believe the Gospel of Jesus unto salvation for mankind. They quote many verses from the Bible and even say flatly that they believe what Christians believe, even calling themselves Christians. What is behind the Mormon salvation?

- Polygamy here and in the here-after
- Church members become gods (the same satanic lie given to Eve in the Garden of Eden)
- Males in heaven have eternal, perpetual sex with their multiple heavenly wives, producing spiritual beings to inhabit worlds across the universe. This is used as a selling point to bring followers into the fold.
- Jesus is the product of sex between a mommy god and a daddy god of which there are many in Mormon heaven,
- Jesus is the brother of Satan
- Deny the Trinity
- Works are necessary for salvation
- False implementation of the Old Testament Levitical tithe and a mandatory payroll deduction plan, before taxes...
- Other writings rule equal or supreme to the Bible: i.e. The Book of Mormon, The Pearl of Great Price, Doctrines and Covenants.
- They claim their faulty works and continued revelations are in harmony with the Bible when they are not.
- The Mormons require of their children a two-year term of proselytizing - spreading a false god, a false Jesus, a false spirit, and a false gospel across the world, complicit with Satan in the ruination and damnation of souls.

- They teach a false god, a false Jesus, a false spirit, and a false gospel with a Bible and other writings that say what they want them to say.
- Mormons do not believe in the rapture and are convinced they will endure the Tribulation. They're right!
- **Mormons:** "From our perspective, the living, breathing, ever-relevant nature of the word of God is linked not to written words, not even to the writing of Moses or Isaiah or Malachi, not to the four Gospels or the epistles of Paul, but rather to the spirit of prophecy and revelation..." Translation: We don't care what the Bible says, we'll just make stuff up as we choose and call it prophecy and revelation!
- **Mormons:** "There are times, of course, when latter-day revelation provides clarification of additional information to the Bible." Translation: We'll tell you what the Bible means and what we want you to know about the Bible, and we'll make up whatever we decide that suits our purpose in the need of the moment.

The Jehovah's witnesses use the same definition of "Gospel" as do other Christian sects. Of course, it is the wrong Gospel message.

JW definition of the Gospel

As used in the Bible, the **gospel**, or good news, refers to the message about the Kingdom of God and of salvation by faith in Jesus Christ.

“Salvation by Faith in Jesus.”... So, who is this Jesus of whom they speak and what do they believe of salvation?

1. Jesus is a created being, like an angel
2. Jesus was born as a human
3. Jesus did not experience physical resurrection
4. Jesus’ second coming occurred in 1914 and caused WWI (say what?)
5. They deny the trinity
6. Jehovah’s Witnesses believe that
 - salvation requires faith in Christ, **plus**
 - association with God’s organization (i.e., their religion), **plus**
 - obedience to its rules. (the rules of JW hierarchy)
7. Two classes of people: the hierarchy of the past church leaders (the 144,000) and the rest of the JW adherents (This is a pyramid scheme meaning the first in get the benefits - much like selling Tupperware)
8. The Spirit is an impersonal force
9. JW’s do not believe in Hell
10. Jesus is not God incarnate

The JW’s believe in a false Jesus, a false god, a false spirit, and proclaim a false gospel from their very own home made false Bible. If they are counting on salvation from their fake, made-up Jesus, they will be waiting a long time. These people, living a delusion, are ripe for the “strong delusion that they might believe a lie” that God will give deceivers such as these during the Tribulation. They are already badly deceived. The poor kids born the these people....

The JW’s also mount a door-to-door campaign to proselytize their communities, seeking souls that they might mislead with their false religion. All for their master, the Devil.

Evangelicalism

False Gospels: many

Beginning in the early 20th century, liberalism took hold of the religious stage while fundamentalists took three giant steps backwards. Truly, there was nothing the fundamental church could have done to stop the satanic liberal steam roller that would soon flatten and putrefy the religious landscape.

In 1900, beginning with the Pentecostal "tongue speak", the final countdown began for the last 120 years of mankind in the final Jubilee of the 119 previous. Religion was going to change for the worse in a decline that would lead to the full-on apostasy we see today.

Evangelicalism, having roots as far back as the 18th century, began to change in the early 20th century from their quasi-solid protestant doctrinal position, becoming increasingly a watered-down version of it's former self.

The false concept of personal evangelism took hold in the mid 20th century, leading to a fictionalized view of church growth dominating the agenda. First came the **seeker sensitive**, then **seeker friendly** churches where the congregation thought it clever to morph themselves into any form and format that might better appeal to the unchurched pagan masses. Then came the **seeker driven** church with rock music, a bar-like atmosphere, and feel good, self-help sermons of humanism to entertain an audience who would rather hear anything but Bible doctrine.

Consider **In the four Jewish Gospels, during His three-year ministry, Jesus went to the Jew only, deliberately omitting the Gentiles and calling them "dogs", His words. Neither Jesus nor His disciples ministered to, or interacted with the Gentiles, avoiding them entirely, and referring to both the Gentiles and Samaritans as heathens, and sinners.**

Post-ascension, Jesus commissioned the Apostle Paul to minister to the Gentiles with a new message that Christ never spoke to His disciples; information the world had never heard, information that God chose for the Gentiles to receive from the mouth of the Apostle Paul, information that had nothing to do with the Jewish Old Testament or the four Jewish Gospels.

That the Christian religion of today believes that Jesus, 2000 years ago, spoke specifically to them, a misguided, biblically ignorant group of Gentiles, without God or the Spirit of God, despising the Jews, preaching a false gospel, a false Spirit, and a phony Jesus, ignoring Christ's messenger to the Gentiles, the Apostle Paul - and they thinking Jesus commanded them into the mission field to convert the world to their brand of made-up religion is beyond absurd.

Spiritual growth can not occur in secularism and without God and without the Spirit of God. Subsequent generations of evangelical progressives, increasingly liberal, set a course for the church that quickly devolved into a social gospel, and inclusivity where anything goes. The desire for growth at all cost was costly, completely gutting the Pauline church model of the Body of Christ.

Finally, the Emergent Church arrived, the inevitable outcome of continued degradation in an increasingly godless religion. Its members, dissatisfied with the constraints of the organized institutional church and religion, sought instead to live their faith as a post-modern secular society, and attempted to reinvent their church from within - without boundaries, doctrines, the Bible, or God. While they hijacked the name "Christian", and words found in Christianity, it is the opposite of the Christian religion. This religion is lost, having no connection to the Body of Christ. Neither does Christianity have the Spirit of God. Emergence is more akin to far east religious mysticism and new age religion than anything Bible. Think Buddhism.

While evangelicalism preached words from the Bible, the meaning of these words were skewed, then lost and forgotten completely. Now, when they speak of the Gospel of Jesus and salvation, their Jesus is not the Jesus of the Bible, but a made-up creation for people to follow and emulate with any number of made-up attributes that do not appear in the Bible. It is merely a false god for these people to worship, a distraction from, and replacement of the one true God. Needless to say, God is not in this religion, never has been, and certainly does not bless this religion.

This progressive evolution sans the Bible is leading the movement into ecumenical-ism as they no longer see the difference between truth and error, or right and wrong. Today they float the false gospels of "You're OK, I'm OK", and all religions lead to Heaven, all roads lead to Heaven, everyone is praying to the same god, everyone goes to Heaven, their god is pure love, god would never judge anyone, their god will welcome everyone, God is not a God of wrath, Jesus loves you no matter what you do, etc. Talk about your false gospels. There are several varieties of religion called Presbyterian formed by splits and mergers over the years. All these groups follow Covenant / Reformed Theology: a satanic theology with the express intent of confusing the Bible, keeping people from God, an damning as many as possible to an eternity without God. You do not need to look very closely to see that this aptly describes this wayward religion and everyone is drinking the Kool-aid. The "USA" derivative is particularly liberal, believing various non-biblical concepts, wickedness, and what Paul calls vile affections and shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret. The Almighty calls it perversion.

Presbyterian Church (USA) advocates homosexuality, lesbianism, gay marriage, homosexual clergy, and any and all forms of LGBTQXYZ+++++. In 2014, they changed the definition of marriage to "two people." In 2015 the denomination ordained a "married" lesbian couple. Not surprisingly, they take a liberal stand on everything including abortion.

On their website, they seek to defend their anti-biblical positions by appealing to "context". The one sure thing these lost souls most definitely lack is Bible context. Note that Covenant Theology cannot understand the Bible due to their lack of God's Spirit, so, they look at the Bible allegorically, spiritualizing scripture to fit there needs and desires of the moment. In this way, like a Ouija Board, they can push the planchette in what ever direction they desire and call their divination spiritual revelation and pretend it is truth "in context". They can make the Bible say anything they want it to say, and they do, including their god's approval of anything and everything the true God of the Bible calls perversions.

Not only do they lack biblical context and the Spirit of God, they lack the blessing of God. What they do have in abundance is the wrath of God. They don't know it, but their days are numbered, and it is not a very big number.

Fun Fact: Notice that the Mormon and Catholic Churches are alive and well in this day-and-age despite their total ignorance of all things God and Bible. Hinduism and Islam also thrive as does the Anglican Church, Orthodoxy, Buddhism, and

Confucianism. So too, the cults and the occults, the atheists, and agnostics, and religions of the far east. There are numerous other religions that fit this mold including the many shades of Protestantism. All told, these belief systems represent billions of lost souls, the vast bulk of humanity.

God allows these false religions and non religions to continue as the wheat and the tares. Very soon, the removal of the Body of Christ from the earth (the rapture) will separate God's children from the lost and the religious, who follow a form of godliness, but deny the power thereof.

And it is not just this religion, but all of the Protestant derivatives follow this pattern to some extent.

Other Presbyterian Derivatives

Presbyterians generally follow the gospel of Jesus. They mostly show their faith through social justice and humanity.

The Gospel of Jesus is the Gospel Jesus gave His disciples - the kingdom of Heaven is at hand - and does not pertain to Gentiles in general or the Body of Christ in particular, and never has. It is an inaccurate belief, biblically speaking.

As the quote above indicates, this religion "mostly" follows a form of social justice and good works that they believe "generally follows" the Gospel of Jesus. Many religions follow this error of works. This concept underscores their errant idea that Christ already returned to earth in AD 70, and is currently ruling the world from Heaven, and will not return to earth until Reformed Religion saves the world and peace is achieved throughout. This is not a biblical concept, not biblically accurate, and will never happen, so says the Bible. In fact, it is fully opposite of biblical truth.

These Covenant religions would not agree with the Pauline epistles, especially Romans, where Paul champions the Jews. Covenantals promote Replacement Theology meaning they see themselves as the replacement of the Jews, and that God no longer has any dealings with the Jews or plans for the Jews. The Christian Church is now God's favored son, The Christian Church is Israel, and all the New Testament was written to them and for them for doctrine and guidance. All this they made up out of thin air as there is nothing anywhere that says any such thing. None of this is true

It is also of interest, that on their web page (brpc.org), there is no mention of the Spirit of God. Once again, this religion presents a solid statement of the Gospel and salvation, and the members can quote Scripture verbatim, but the religion itself has nothing to do with the Bible. They emphasize a misdirected, misinterpreted, and misunderstood concept of the workings of the Spirit today in signs and wonders, healings, and tongue-speak, making theirs a false religion with a false spirit perpetuating a false gospel. This is another religion of many that is heavily peppered with Bible words, yet, there is not one bit of truth anywhere in this religion.

Fun Fact: Religions that emphasize the Spirit ignore God and Jesus. The “Jesus” religions ignore the Spirit and God. Everything is designed to keep people worshipping a false god and distracted from the One True Creator God.

Fun Fact: The miracles, signs, and wonders, and tongue-speak active during the time of Jesus in the four Jewish Gospels, and during the time of the Apostles covered in the book of Acts, were all replaced with the greater miracle of the indwelling Spirit of God. While the Pentecostals have a false religion based on nothing biblical, an offshoot of this faith, Charismatism, has all the same trappings, but excels as the ultimate in snake oil and flimflam. Among their dodges are the “Name-it-claim-it” movement and the “Word of Faith”, both specialize in separating people from their money while making the front man very rich. Their scam is telling people that God wants them to be rich, but God can’t give to them unless they show faith by first giving to Him. This is a false god. If the people want this false god to bless

them abundantly, they must give abundantly. Everything collected goes right into the pocket of the preacher to support a lavish life style.

This gospel of money-for-money is a false gospel and these charlatans prey on the unfortunate of society that are hit hardest when their big pay-day never materializes. You can also find this despicable tactic at work in many conservative Christian religions around the world - any and every varietal. It is a satanic lie as these preachers know better. They simply need to bilk the audience to keep their operations afloat, not to mention their greed.

Fun Fact: The concept of tithing is nowhere found in the Pauline doctrines and has nothing to do with the Gentiles, the Body of Christ, or even the false religion called Christian that chose to make tithing part of their errant religion.

Like the Pentecostals, Charismatics follow a false spirit and proclaim a false gospel. This religion is not of God and God cannot be with them or bless them. So, at best, they are nothing but a gathering of people, void of the Spirit, out there on their own, chanting Bible words and singing repetitious songs in the name of a fictitious deity, flailing their hands as they compete with one-another to see who can make the most noise and draw the most attention. Everyone tries to feel good about themselves (like scores of other religions), all the while hoping to hit it rich with a “sugar-daddy god” they try to appease by throwing their money at the feet of the preacher.

The Deception

Don't expect the various Christian religions to show you their cards. Many Church statements sound legit, but on closer examination you will find numerous flaws in what they choose to say, what they chose to omit, and what they really believe and teach.

- A Covenant Church might give you a statement full of Bible words, and references to various Bible verses, but most of the words and references are taken out of context and do not support what the religion is saying.
- There may be numerous references to “Jesus”: have the love of Jesus, share the love of Jesus, be like Jesus, make disciples for Jesus, have the mission of Jesus, follow Jesus, be a disciple of Jesus, have the heart of Jesus, etc.
 - This is not the message or intent of the Bible
 - Not the Jesus of the Bible.
 - Not the Pauline Christ
 - The goal behind this false Jesus is distracting you from a relationship with the one true God. Some religions use the goddess Mary for the same purpose.
- These statements completely omit the indwelling Spirit of God which is the mystery hid in God from the beginning of the world, and the Power behind the Christian life. The indwelling Spirit is what separates the Body of Christ from

the world of fortune-cookie religions. Christ gave this mystery to the Apostle Paul that he might take it to the Gentiles.

- The indwelling Spirit is not only the simplicity of Christ, it is the power of God in the believers life. Instead, religions focus on religiosity: the form and function, church government, empty rituals and practices, chants, prayers, laws, all wrapped in a pagan style worship of a phony deity. This is nothing but cheap, plastic, religious quackery, not the all important relationship with God, and not “Christ in you” that defines the Pauline Body of Christ.
- Some churches present long statements of faith and belief that give the impression of being thorough and complete, but this is merely a distraction from the many missing mentions that should be included so that you might know what they really believe. These missing mentions include:
 - Reformed Theology and anti-Zionism,
 - Jesus already returned to earth in 70 AD,
 - No belief in the millennium,
 - No future return of Christ,
 - No rapture of the church,
 - No Indwelling Spirit of God
 - ...and many more.
- Many of these Church statements have expired, written over a century ago by a generation since departed, long before the 20th century descent into liberalism and progressive thought. While the writings may be a sincere attempt at Biblical accuracy, and remain on the books as their guiding light, they are wrong, worn out, and no longer referenced or followed by the current church administrations that float an agenda of “woke” and inclusivity, all the while omitting sound doctrinal teaching. What these Churches teach today has nothing to do with their statements, or the Bible, or God.
- Instead of a local church statement, other denominations refer you to centuries-old church documents such as the 1646 Westminster Confession of Faith, or some creed developed by some Council over a millennia ago. These were attempts to create a rigid religious structure defining faith, worship, and church government, but badly missed the mark then, and are just as worthless today, creating a cold, sterile, religion of law and obedience, void of the simplicity of Paul’s Gospel, and totally lacking in mention of the indwelling Spirit of God that is the power of the Church and life of the believer. Truly, the entire 800 pages of this nonsense could be replaced with a couple of bullet-points.

Conclusion

All these religions, and many more, proclaim a Gospel of salvation through Jesus, but what hides behind the curtain often has nothing to do with the Spirit of God, Paul’s ascended Christ,
