

## Can You Trust the Commentaries?

---

***Many commentaries have a bias toward Covenant Theology thereby misinterpreting the Bible and rendering them useless as a study aid.***

Christianity is a religion that encompasses many sects and denominations. **The Christianity of today is NOT the Body of Christ seen in the first century Pauline epistles.** It is something else.

There are numerous Bible schools, seminaries, preachers, books, churches, and parishioners attached to Covenant religion. Thus, followers of Christianity who write about their religion do so along the lines of their beliefs. This includes commentaries. These materials do not necessarily reflect the truth of the Bible as the Covenant religion does not have the Spirit of God and therefore does not understand the Bible.

**Fun Fact:** Christianity is nowhere found in the Bible. It is a made-up religion like Mormonism, Catholicism, Pentecostalism, Amishism, and other such belief systems. These are all creations of men who took words from the Bible, out of context, to concoct their false ideas, and/or traditions, superstitions, imaginations, beliefs, extra-biblical writings, and errant practices that have no biblical support.

**Fun Fact:** Christianity is not a valid expression of Bible truth.

**Fun Fact:** Generally speaking, Christianity is nothing more than a collection of random Bible verses taken out of context.

The Christian population of the world is roughly 2.6 billion people. Most follow Covenant Theology or have some form of Covenant influence.

Generations have lived their entire life knowing nothing but Covenant religion and a Covenant view of the Bible. These men and women have taken to heart their religion, firmly believing they have God's truth, the complete truth, and that theirs is the only right religion in the world. However, other people feel the same about their religion: Buddhists, Confucianists, Hindus, Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormons, Muslims, and the list goes on. Everyone believes their religion is the right one.

**Fun Fact:** Religion of every type is the single greatest satanic deception ever perpetrated upon the world, from idolatry, Confucianism, Islam, Christianity, and the rest,

Covenant Theology marginalizes Paul in favor of the four Jewish Gospels and the life and ministry of Jesus. In so doing, they ignore God's message to mankind in this Age of Grace. This eliminates God's blessings from the Christian religion. This means no Spirit of God for guidance and direction. Without the Spirit, Covenantals lack understanding and read the Bible allegorically, spiritualizing the

parts of the text they cannot understand or explain. This results in the Covenant religion not having the truth of God, and having the fate of the Jews which is blind, lost, and headed for the Tribulation.

Using commentaries in your study of the Bible, if written by Covenant writers, will guaranty you a heavy dose of Covenant Theology: a view of what the authors think the Bible says; running everything through the filter of the four Jewish Gospels and the ministry of the Gospel Jesus, and the Jewish Hebrew epistles, all obsolete. Nothing here applies to the Gentiles. They ignore the Apostle Paul, the man Christ sent to the Gentiles with the message God wants us to hear. Reading material with a Covenant perspective will give you a warped sense of the Bible and you will not find the truth or the spiritual growth you seek, only confusion in a false religion. You will not find an emphasis on the Pauline doctrines Christ gave the Body of Christ through the Apostle Paul.

If you wish to understand the Bible, and you have a relationship with God, rely on the indwelling Spirit of God to lead you through the Bible, and to open your eyes to the truth. In these last minutes of mankind, it is the only option available.
